For the last four months, the St. Jacob U.C.C. has been a construction zone. We were getting accustomed to apologizing for the inconvenience, but not for much longer! On December 11, we will be returning to worship in our newly renovated sanctuary.

The plans for the day include two morning services.

The *first* service of worship in the new sanctuary will take place at 9:00 a.m., on Sunday, December 11.

The Sunday School Children and congregation will gather outside by the new front doors at 9:00 a.m. for a ribbon cutting and pictures. We will then process into the Sanctuary for morning worship with special music by the Guthrie Brothers. Following the Children's Time, the young people will follow their teachers to their assigned classrooms, to continue with their Christmas Program Practice, and worship will continue.

Following the first service, there will be a coffee hour in Heritage Hall from 10:00 a.m. until 10:30a.m.

At 10:30 a.m., the *second* service will include the Dedication of the new sanctuary, including a sermon from the Rev. David Greenhaw, President of Eden Theological Seminary, music by the Guthries, and the Dedication.

Immediately following the late service, a celebratory Fellowship Dinner will follow in Heritage Hall. The church will be providing the meal, a delicious Sausage Dinner with all the sides. In keeping with our Second Sunday custom, those staying for the meal are asked to bring a dessert to share. (Perhaps a tray of the first Christmas cookies of the season?)

Please note, there is no charge for the Second Sunday Sausage Dinner, but we are distributing tickets for the meal, in order to make appropriate preparations according to our expected attendance.

Through December 4th, you can pick up tickets before and after worship on Sundays, or pick yours up at the church office during business hours. There may be some limit on the number of tickets available, so please pick yours up at your earliest convenience.

Finally, and very importantly, such arrangements as are being made for the Rededication Sunday would not be possible without the generous support and co-operation of our brothers and sisters in our yoked congregation of St. John, Summerfield. We owe them a great debt of thanks, and very much look forward to their joining with us in worship and fellowship on this special occasion.

There will be no morning service at St. John on December 11th.
